NAAE Outstanding Service Award Application

The NAAE Outstanding Service Award recognizes experienced agricultural educators who have made significant contributions to agricultural education by supporting teachers and students on the local, state, region, and/or national level. These humble leaders have spent their careers energized by the responsibility of shaping the future one student at a time.

Who can apply?

All active and active life NAAE members, except current members of the NAAE board of directors, are eligible to apply. Each applicant must have been a NAAE member the ten (10) previous years or continuously since the applicant began teaching. At the national level, NAAE members must at least be in their twentieth (20th) year of teaching agriculture at the time they apply to NAAE. Individuals may receive the regional award only once; previous regional winners are not eligible to apply.

Awards and Recognition

Each state winner will receive a sponsored certificate at the annual meeting of the state agricultural educator's association. NAAE will recognize six national winners, one from each NAAE region. All state winners will compete within their respective NAAE region for the regional award. Each regional winner will receive: (1) complimentary registration for the 2025 NAAE Convention in Nashville, Tennessee, and (2) an engraved plaque. **Travel and hotel will be the responsibility of the award winner or nominating state association**.

The deadline for submitting state winning applications to the national NAAE office is May 15, 2025.

All applications must be submitted through the NAAE Online Application system. No printed or emailed applications will be accepted.

Award Application Instructions:

Applicants must complete the online submission of this award by May 15th through their MyNAAE account. All required components must be included, and membership requirements and eligibility must be met to be eligible to apply.

Required Components of the Application:

1. **Applicant Information** – the first portion of the application must be the completed online though the MyNAAE portal on the NAAE website. Applicants must log-in and provide updated applicant information.

All items listed below should be saved as electronic files and uploaded to the online application form through MyNAAE. Printed copies of the items below will not be accepted. Supported file types include .pdf, .doc, .txt, .jpg, .png, .gif, .tif, or .bmp.

- 2. Narrative the narrative is limited to four 8 1/2" x 11" pages. The narrative must be typewritten and uploaded to the online application form. Use a font no smaller than 12 points. Multiple text formats are acceptable, including paragraphs, lists, and tables. The narrative must follow the outline specified as follows:
 - **a. Program Services-** brief description of the applicant's contribution to agricultural educators, agricultural programs, and/or agricultural student organizations. (40%)
 - **b. Professional Activities** brief description of your career path including memberships and engagement in professional organizations, leadership positions and other valuable contributions to the profession. (40%)
 - c. Awards and Honors brief description of your awards and honors acknowledging achievements in, cooperation with, and service in professional organization. (20%)
- **3. Application Signature Sheet –** the application signature page must be signed by the requested individuals and uploaded to the online application form. The application signature page can be found on page 4 of this document.
- 4. Professional Photo or Headshot A high resolution photo in .gif, .jpeg, .png, .bmp, .jpg, or .tif form must be uploaded as part of the online submission of your application.

Requested Components of Application:

1. Additional Photos Related to 2a.-2c. - High resolution photos in .jpeg, .png, .bmp, .jpg, or .tif form can be uploaded as part of the online submission of your application.

State-level Competition

When and Where to Submit: Entries must be submitted to the state association by the deadline established by the state association.

Evaluation Procedures: Each respective state association will determine the selection process for state winners.

National-level Competition

What to Submit: All required components of the application must be submitted online by May 15. No printed or emailed applications will be accepted.

When and Where to Submit: The online application and instructions can be found at <u>www.naae.org</u>.

State presidents will authenticate state winners using the NAAE State Winners' Validation Form provided by NAAE. All state winners must be validated by May 15.

Evaluation Procedures: The evaluation of applications will be completed virtually. Applications will be judged by NAAE regions on a rotational calendar. A committee appointed by NAAE will judge and select regional winners.
