ABOUT

The **National Association of Agricultural Educators** (NAAE) is a federation of state agricultural educators associations with more than 9,000 members. Members are involved in school-based agricultural education at all levels, from middle school through postsecondary, and state and national agricultural education leadership.

NAAE advocates for agricultural education, provides professional development for agricultural educators, and works to recruit and retain agricultural educators in the profession. Offerings include a variety of programs and services to support this three-pronged mission.

School based agricultural education (SBAE) is part of the Career and Technical Education delivery model valued in schools because of the high impact on student learning and practical application of core concepts like literacy, mathematics, science, technology, and engineering. There are more than 8,500 SBAE programs across the US and more than 13,000 agricultural educators delivering this unique model of classroom and lab instruction, leadership development through FFA and supervised agricultural experiences.

NAAE is committed to advancing, in our organization and communities, inclusion, diversity and equity. The choice to create a just and equitable organization is not accidental. We intentionally prioritize fostering an inclusive environment that ensures people are respected and valued. The National Association of Agricultural Educators (NAAE) convention takes place annually, at a different location every year, in conjunction with the Association of Career and Technical Education (ACTE) VISION convention. The VISION convention attracts more than 4,000 attendees of which NAAE members consist of 800-1,100 or more secondary and post-secondary agricultural educators, preservice agricultural educators, agricultural education state staff and agricultural education supporters. NAAE attendees participate in organization business and committee meetings, elect new leadership, network with colleagues and professional representatives and engage in professional development workshops and sessions. Any NAAE member may register and attend, there is also a non-member registration option. The 2023 NAAE Convention is scheduled to take place November 28 – December 2 in Phoenix, Arizona. NAAE ADVOCACY PROGRAMS

The delivery of programming and experiences that support the growth and development of agricultural education programs and agricultural educators to ensure the sustainability and validity of agricultural education across the country.

NAAE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

Robust, timely, rigorous, inclusive, accessible and inquiry based professional development for all phases and needs of teaching tenure.

- NAAE Future Agriscience Teacher (FAST) Symposium
 - Professional development, networking and mentoring program for agricultural education majors.
 - Sessions held remotely and in conjunction with National events like Teach Ag Day, NAAE Convention and National FFA Convention.
 - Inclusion, diversity. Equity and accessibility training embedded into every session.
 - Affiliation programs with MANRRS, AFA, Cultivating Change Foundation
 - Annual Engagement = **200** preservice agricultural education majors
- NAAE Virtual Book Club
 - Summer virtual professional development series for agricultural educators based on a selected education-based book.

- NAAE XLR8
 - Professional development experience for agricultural educators in their 7-15th year of teaching that covers prioritization, delegation, balance, personal wellness and program management.
 - State, Regional and National program coordinated by NAAE and delivered by trained agricultural education facilitators.
 - Annual Engagement = **150** agriculture teachers
- NAAE Teachers Turn the Key
 - Professional development program for early career agricultural educators (1-5 years) to help them develop their program, expectations, goals and lesson delivery.
 - Annual engagement = **35-50** participants
- NAAE National Agriscience Teacher Ambassador Program (NATAP)
 - Inquiry based professional development program that trains teachers in science and inquiry-based lesson and curriculum delivery.
 - Annual engagement = **500** current agricultural educators

- NAAE Agriscience Inquiry Institute (AI²)
 - State level professional development using the inquiry-based lesson delivery model to assist teachers in developing science and inquiry-based lessons.
 - Training sessions are coordinated by NAAE and delivered by trained agricultural educator facilitators who have completed the National Agriscience Teacher Ambassador Program

NAAE TEACHER RECRUITMENT, RETENTION AND RECOGNITION PROGRAMS

Since the early 1970's SBAE programs have struggled to find quality and diverse teacher candidates. In 2009, under the leadership of the National Association of Agricultural Educators the National Teach Ag Campaign was launched to implement sustainable and effective recruitment and retention initiatives throughout the nation. Through the work of the NAAE teacher recruitment and retention programs significant achievements have been made.

- The retention rate of current teachers is at historic levels with an average of 96% of teachers annually staying in the profession.
- Individuals majoring in agricultural education are holding steady even as other content areas are experiencing decreases.
- The conversion rate for new agricultural education graduates is at an all-time high of 75%, that means 75% of new certified agriculture teacher candidates went on to teach agriculture

RECRUITMENT

- NAAE National Teach Ag Day
 - 3rd Thursday in September (except when it falls on Rosh Hashanah and/or Yom Kippur)
 - Day for agriculture teachers and agricultural education supporters to encourage others to think about teaching agriculture and celebrate current teachers.
 - The National Teach Ag Campaign hosts a live webcast on Teach Ag Day from a different location every year.
 - Live audience of 50-100

PRESERVICE TEACHER RETENTION

 - 13 hours of on-site and remote professional development
 - Trained to serve as voices and recruiters back in their home state and institution
 - Staff the Teach Ag booth at National FFA Convention where they interact with **1,000+** FFA members, agriculture teachers, supporters and sponsors
- NAAE Upper Division Scholarship Program
 - Scholarship program for preservice teachers to provide funds during the student teaching semester
 - Currently 30-40 scholarships at \$1,500/each

CURRENT TEACHER RETENTION

- NAAE Wise and Well Program
 - A comprehensive and varied approach program for agricultural educators that provides physical, emotional, mental, financial, and relational wellness support. The program will focus on tangible actions agricultural educators can take to increase their personal and professional satisfaction. NAAE encourages agricultural educators to rise above their current challenges and circumstances to grow personally and professionally to establish and maintain physical, emotional, mental, financial, and relational wellness.
- NAAE Facilitator Training (part of NATAP)
 - As programs grow and improve agriculture teacher facilitators are needed to serve as program trainers and experts. The facilitator training is an ongoing professional development experience for master teachers who are looking for additional opportunities to lead and impact while staying in the classroom. Agriculture teacher facilitators are needed for TTTK, XLR8, AI2, NATAP, FAST and more.
