
5. Did you take agriculture classes during high school?



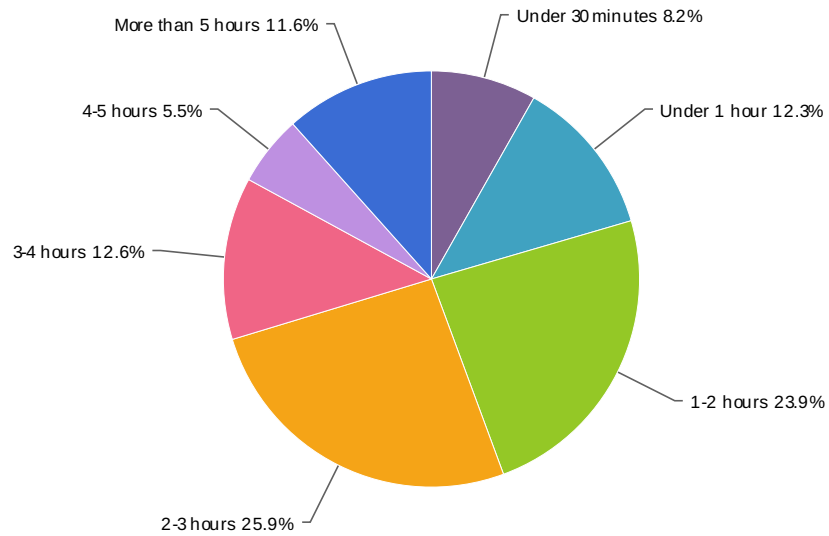

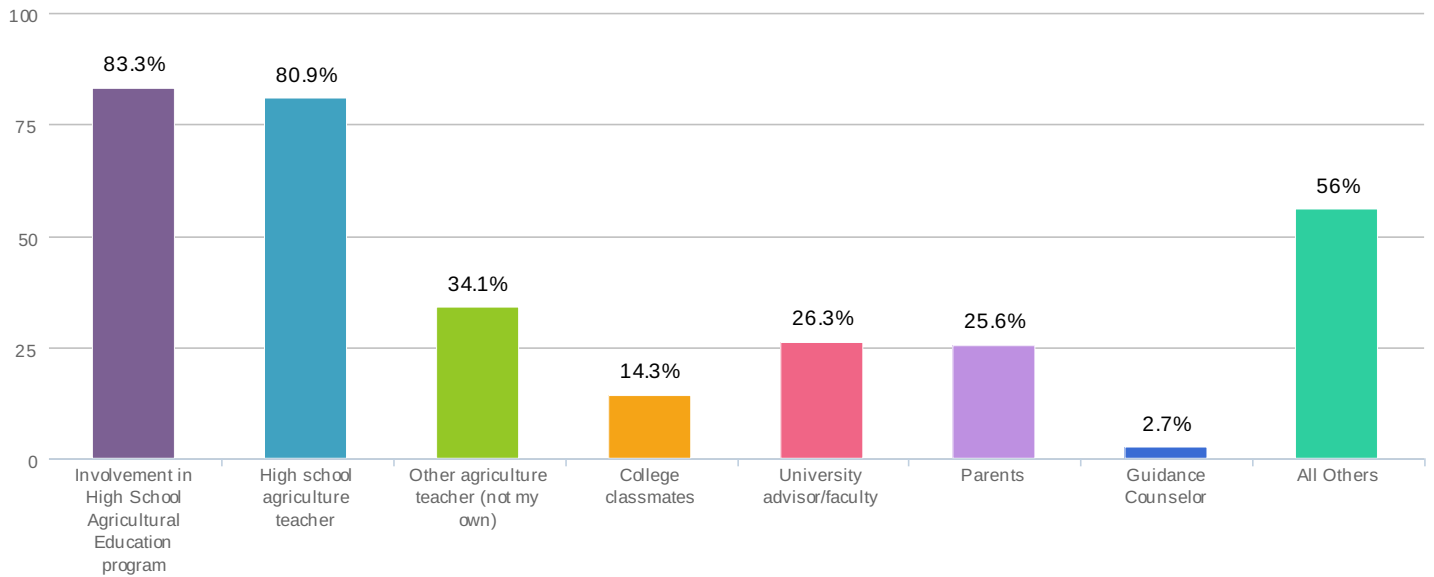

7. How long does it take you to drive from college to your hometown?



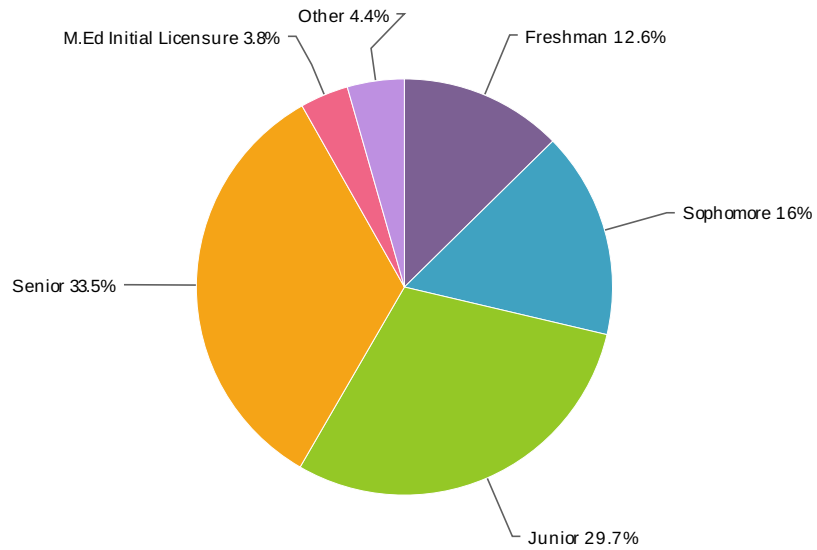

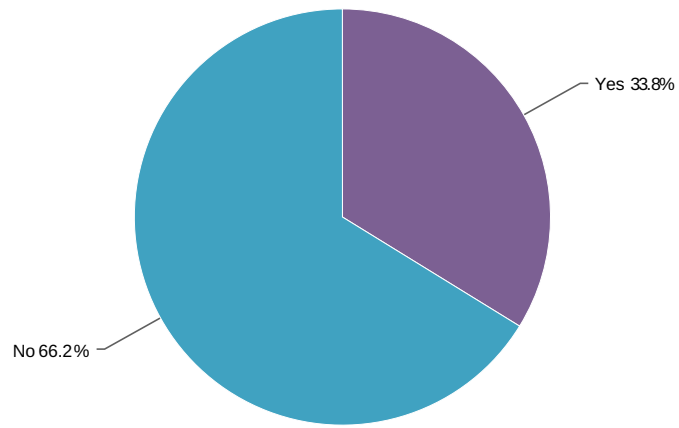

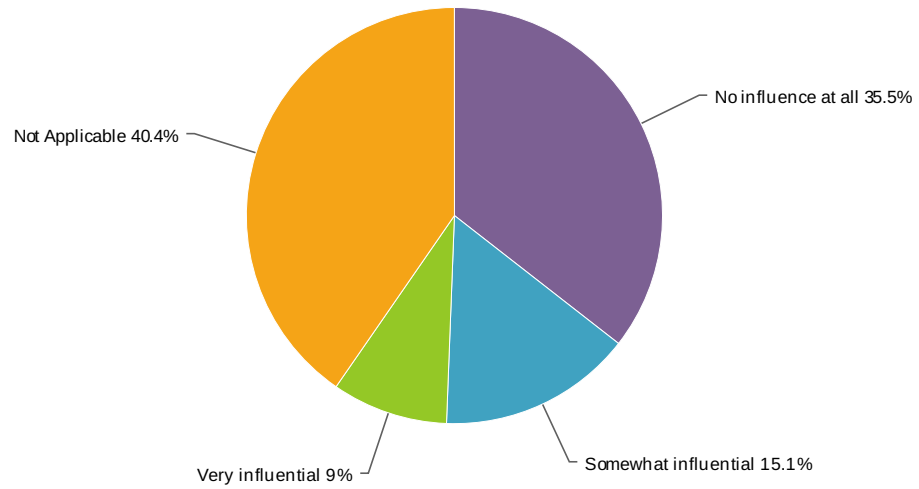

12. Did you receive a scholarship specifically for agricultural education majors?



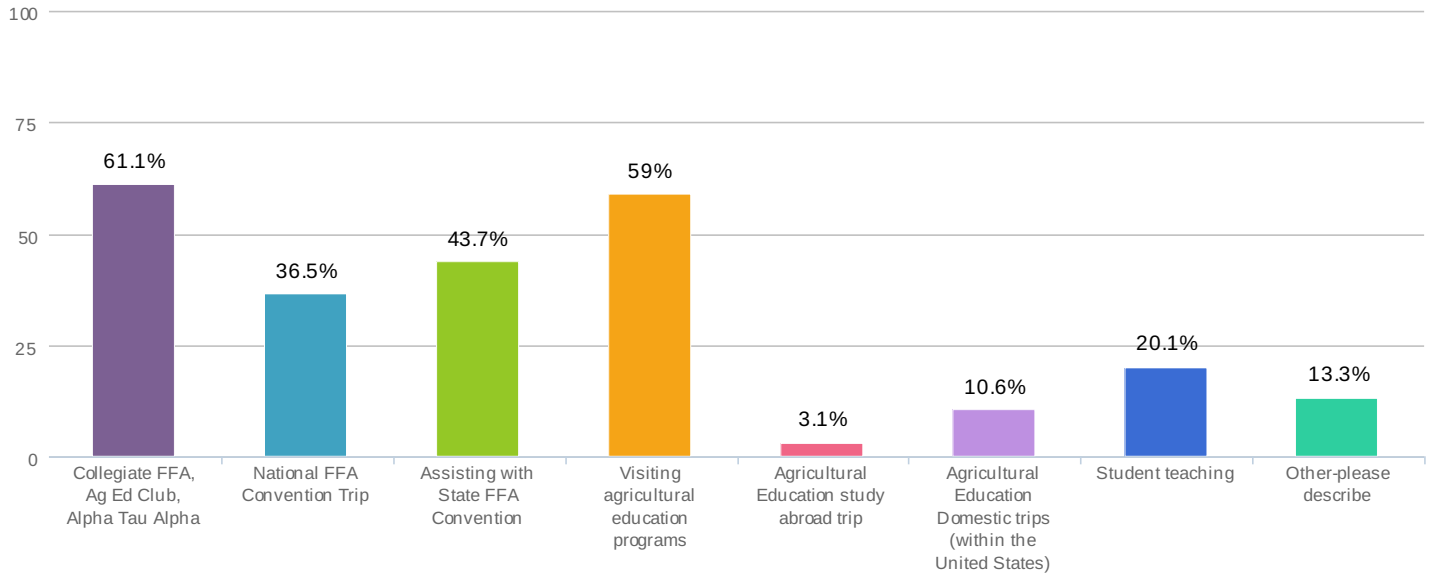
